Lisa Ward of Dallas walked away with special honors for having the highest Freestyle score with a 35.8 and even though it wasn't needed, she also had the highest Catch Ratio for the day at 86%. But in the end, the Toss N Catch score is what clinched it for Mark McNitt & Jackson from Houston to take 2nd place and Pennie Mahon & Gabe from Houston taking 3rd. Kelly Miller & Rio and Lisa Ward & Brie both of Dallas rounded out 4th and 5th.

This year there were enough competitors to warrant the need for a Freestyle round in the Intermediate Division with 13 competitors. It was an exciting day and in the end Deb Carlson & Taz (Houston) took 1st place by 0.4 pts over our friendly Boomer Sooner, Lee Fairchild & Gracie, of Oklahoma. Christopher Steele & Ringo finished in a strong 3rd place.

There was only one Toss N Catch division this year with novice and experienced all lumped together. But again, past favorites were daunted by unpredictable winds and there were many a missed discs snatched from the ground versus snatched from the air! Lee Fairchild (Oklahoma) & General took first with a total of 14 pts. Kathy Richards (Dallas) swept 2nd and 3rd with Freckles and Poppy, respectively.
